Background & General Description:	
<p>P4G - Partnering for Green Growth and the Global Goals 2030</p> <p>P4G - Partnering for Green Growth and the Global Goals 2030 - is a global initiative with the ambition of becoming the world's leading forum for developing concrete public-private partnerships at scale to deliver on the SDGs and the Paris Climate Agreement. By providing funding and active acceleration support to partnership ideas, P4G brings together business, government, and civil society organisations in innovative and market-based partnerships to advance solutions that help meet the world's greatest needs in five key SDG areas: food and agriculture (SDG2), water (SDG6), energy (SDG7), cities (SDG11) and circular economy (SDG12).</p> <p>P4G is set-up as a cross-country, cross-sector, cross-organisational initiative, where collaboration and mobilization of actors is central to the way P4G operates. P4G has partner countries (currently Chile, Colombia, Denmark, Ethiopia, the Netherlands, Kenya, Mexico, South Korea, and Vietnam) that play an important role in advancing the P4G model. P4G also has partner organisations, which bring cutting-edge knowledge and inspiration to P4G and its partnerships. Partner organisations include the Global Green Growth Institute (GGGI), C40, the World Economic Forum (WEF), UN Global Compact, the International Finance Corporation (IFC) and World Resources Institute (WRI).</p> <p>P4G is managed by an International Coordination Hub (P4G Hub) hosted by WRI in Washington DC.</p>	
Roles & Responsibility:	
<p>The Senior Advisor will be part of the P4G Hub in Washington DC. For information, see https://p4gpartnerships.org/. The Senior Advisor will report to the Global Director and be part of the leadership team, responsible for the implementation of P4G. The position is financed by Danish ODA and as such</p>	

should pay particular attention to engagement in developing countries or exercising thought leadership on how ODA can better leverage concrete partnerships in developing countries.

This position will play a strategic role to ensure long-term engagement from P4G partner countries and partner organisations that will position P4G as the world's leading forum for developing innovative market-based partnership solutions at scale to deliver on the SDGs and the Paris Agreement. The duration of the contract is two years with the possibility of extension for another final year.

Specific responsibilities include the following:

- Lead engagement and relationship management with funding partners including current and prospective country funding partners, streamlining funding and reporting channels and within this context support long term engagement in the P4G initiative
- Develop and implement strategy for unlocking partner organisations knowledge, network and resources to engage actively in building up national platforms in partner countries and strengthening partnerships under implementation
- Support the director and the leadership team by developing and maintaining a strong external network in the P4G community and by working with counterparts build consensus on the P4G work program
- Manage relationship and participate in financial discussions and negotiations with key global investment fora and relevant DFIs (IFC, SDG Fund etc.)
- Be a P4G champion, with ability to explain P4G's approach and benefits to funding partners and provide strategic insights and direction for responding to requests in an efficient and effective manner

Selection Criteria & Competencies:

The successful candidate will have the following qualifications, experience, skills and personal attributes:

- Advanced degree in a relevant discipline (Masters or PhD), and at least 10 years of relevant full-time experience.

- Demonstrated knowledge in how to engage governments in initiatives like P4G including through negotiating funding for international and multilateral initiatives
- Demonstrated experience to cultivate and maintain relationships with high-level stakeholders from public, private and non-government sectors
- Experience in leadership roles and extensive knowledge on advancing commercial/financial models and market-based solutions to SDG and Paris Agreement implementation in developing countries and on emerging markets
- Demonstrated ability to work in international teams including mentoring staff. Experience in working across disciplinary boundaries, with multiple stakeholders to build and maintain a network
- Demonstrated ability to work independently and build strong professional relationships with senior public and private sector actors
- Significant experience acting as an ambassador for international and multilateral initiatives including presenting at conferences and in forums
- Ability to independently deliver quality outputs in a timely manner and to work under pressure; ability to take initiative, think innovatively and translate ideas into actions
- Commitment to P4G Partnership's mission, values, and approach
